

### Report from WDA Delegate, Jean McLean



The House of Delegates Leadership Team is soliciting the names of potential members to serve on the prevention of Childhood Obesity Coalition. Please submit the names of potential candidates to me by Monday August 17, 2009. The Coalition will determine an integrated action plan for all RDs/DTRs, ADA and ADA organizational units based on extensive input provided during the Spring 2009 Virtual HOD Meeting dialogue session on the prevention of childhood obesity. The action plan will include a tracking mechanism and evaluation component for measuring progress to prevent childhood obesity. The House of Delegates requests the coalition to reach out to all stakeholders. The action plan will be due no later than May 1, 2010. A report on progress will be submitted by the task force (or coalition) to the House of Delegates no later than May 1, 2011. The work of the coalition will be conducted by conference call.

The coalition will be composed of 5-7 ADA members with expertise in the area of childhood obesity and should represent various areas of dietetics practice. The commitment for serving on the coalition will be two years (ending on May 21, 2011).
