Discreet

- Compact design

Injection-Free Dosing

- Fewer injections
- 1 device = 9 mealtime injections

- 1 Prescribe CeQur Simplicity 2U Patch, 10 Pack
 - Includes: 10 2-Unit Patches, Quick Start Guide, Dose Count Card, Change By Stickers
 - · NDC: 73108000001
- 2 Prescribe CeQur Simplicity Inserter
 - Includes: 1 Inserter, Quick Start Guide, User Guide
 - NDC: 73108000100
- 3 Prescribe a vial of rapid-acting insulin
 - CeQur Simplicity is labeled for use with Humalog® U-100 or Novolog® U-100
- 4 Have patients call CeQur Care at 1-888-55-CeQur (1-888-552-3787)
 - A healthcare provider from your office or a CeQur Care healthcare professional will train the patient







CeQur Simplicity is covered on most commercial and Medicare Part D insurance plans as a pharmacy benefit.

Where covered, most patients have a co-pay of \$50 or less a month. Individual plans and pharmacy benefits may vary by patient.
